Please note the pictures of the ladies dipping water from the stream. The stream is the water source for hundreds of people while this borehole is broken. The hand pump was broken for 3 or 4 months and during that time the people collected their drinking water from where you see the ladies. The picture with the clothes is an example of the same water source being used for drinking and washing. In one picture you can see the mire/dirty water which is from the cows drinking from the same water source and also relieving themselves in the same area where the people are drawing from. This is not the exception in many parts of Zambia--but the rule. Now you can see how the people become so sick and many die.
